團費包括：

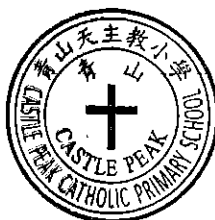
- 來回香港至新西蘭經濟客位機票連兩地機場稅及航空公司燃油附加費

Homestay:

All students will live in New Zealand English speaking families with children. Meals will be provided by the families. Students will be driven to and from school, or take bus with Helensville schoolmates or teachers. All families have been vetted by the school staff and the police.

Lessons:

Each student will be assigned a school buddy. During school days, they will have lessons in their buddies' class. Some special classes will also be arranged for the Hong Kong students.

Tour:

City tour

The City tour is to let students have an idea about the Auckland City. On the way, the bus will go past different places in central city, such as Queen's Street, Sky Tower and the University.

Muriwai Beach

On Wednesday afternoon, students will visit the Muriwai Beach with a spectacular view of the Tasman Sea and the black sand beach. The most interesting spot is the gannet colony where gannets can be watched at a close distance.

Rotorua tour

In Rotorua, the tour will cover themes on volcanoes and thermal activities, sheep farming and Maori culture. Students can see the magnificent geyser and mud pools, and visit the kiwi bird and watch a farm show. They will also take a gondola up Skyline and try the exciting game of lugging.
